Your proxy will also be entitled to vote at his discretion properly put to the Meeting other than those referred to in the notice convening the Meeting.
- 5. This proxy form must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing or in the case of a corporation must be either under its common seal or under the hand of an officer or attorney duly authorised in that behalf.
- 6. Where there are joint registered holders of any Shares, any one of such persons may vote at the Meeting, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such Shares as if he was solely entitled thereof, but if more than one of such joint holders be present at the Meeting personally or by proxy, that one of the said persons so present whose name stands first on the register of members in respect of such Shares shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof.
- 7. In order to be valid, this proxy form, together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a certified copy thereof, must be deposited at the Company's branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Tricor Investor Services Limited, at Level 54, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time fixed for holding the Meeting or at any adjournment thereof (as the case may be).
- 8. The proxy need not be a member of the Company but must attend the Meeting in person to represent you.
- Completion and delivery of the proxy form will not preclude you from attending and voting at the Meeting if you so wish, but the authority of your proxy will be invalid forthwith.

PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTION STATEMENT

- (iv) You have the right to request access to and/or correction of your Personal Data in accordance with the provisions of the PDPO.
